## Driving Directions to NSU'S Main Campus

### From I-95 or Florida's Turnpike

Exit at I-595; proceed west to University Drive exit. Turn left (south) onto University Drive. Proceed approximately 1 ½ miles to SW 30 Street (Abe Fischler Blvd.), turn left (east). NSU's main campus will be on the right side.

### From University Drive

#### ***From North of I-595***

Take University Drive south 1 ½ miles past I-595 to SW 30 Street (Abe Fischler Blvd). Turn left (east). NSU's main campus will be on the right side.

#### ***From south of Griffin Road***

Take University Drive north approximately 2 miles past Griffin Road to SW 30 Street (Abe Fischler Blvd.). Turn right (east). NSU's main campus will be on the right side.

### From I-75

#### ***From Miami heading north or west coast/Naples heading east***

Merge onto I-595 eastbound (towards Fort Lauderdale). Exit at University Drive exit, turn right (south). Proceed approximately 1 ½ miles on University Drive to SW 30 Street (Abe Fischler Blvd.), turn left (east). NSU's main campus will be on the right side.

### Public Transportation:

From Fort Lauderdale International airport use bus line 6 to Broward Central Terminal. At Broward Central Terminal transfer to line 9. Get off at the NSU campus (Davie Road stop). ## **SFEC/Tri-Rail Express**

Free SFEC/Tri-Rail Express shuttles are available from the Fort Lauderdale Airport Tri-Rail Station to the SFEC campus in Davie and back. The SFEC (South Florida Education Center) includes the Davie campuses of NSU, BCC, FAU, McFatter, and UF. ## **Access the Maltz Building**

Upon turning onto SW 30 Street, travel east (You will pass the Miami Dolphins Training Camp on your right hand side). You will notice several entrances into the main campus on your right hand side. The entrance for the Maltz building is the last entrance before College Avenue. Make your first right after passing the “End of School Zone Sign” into the entrance for the Maltz Building. At the stop sign, turn left and make a right into the parking lot.
